SENATOR NICHOL: Yes, Senator Chambers, did you have a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, how late were you going to stay today?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Two o'clock. Is this too complicated a bill? Well, if it is, why don't we move on to, unless there is objection, can we move on to the next bill to try to get a couple....?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, if there is no objection we will pass over 378 and 378A. Let's refer to LB 141. If any other legislator in the next five minutes has a bill they would like to take up on this list, please let the Chair know.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 141.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Now, Mr. Clerk, do you have any other amendments on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goodrich had an amendment to the bill but Senator Goodrich is excused for the day.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I am familiar with the amendment. Senator Goodrich has given me a copy. However, I suggested to him that we can either place it on here or we can bring it back from E & R engrossing for that specific amendment. I am suggesting we pass over it, move it, because that amendment may be somewhat controversial because it deals with roles and missions. So I am sure Senator Goodrich will not be upset if we just pass over it and move the bill to E & R for engrossing and then let him bring it back for that amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. You so move?

SENATOR KOCH: I so move, Mr. Speaker.
