ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, 5 present and not voting, 10 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1890 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 354 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 39.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 39.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 39 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 38 ayes, no nays, 1 present and not voting, 10 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1891 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 39 passes with the emergency clause attached on Final Reading. We will now read on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk LB 252.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 252.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 252 pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 42 ayes, no nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President. Vote appears on pages 1891-1892 of the Legislative Journal.
