LB 356, 425, 576

SENATOR GEORGE: Speaker Marvel, why is 356 going to be pulled back? Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, excuse me.

PRESIDENT: All right, what Speaker Marvel is saying is that if Senator Lewis arrives we are going to go back and take it up. So, we will go then next Mr. Clerk on Final Reading we will take up 425. LB 425 on Final Reading.

CLERK: Read LB 425.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall LB 425 pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 41 ayes, no nays, 4 excused and not voting, and 4 present and not voting, Mr. President. Vote appears on pages 1900-1901 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: LB 425 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 576.

CLERK: Read LB 576.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 576 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 44 ayes, no nays, 4 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 576 passes with the emergency clause attached on Final Reading. Before we take up 576A the Chair would like to introduce from Senator Wesely's District some 18 fourth grade students, three teachers and two parents from Trinity Lutheran Elementary School here in Lincoln.
