SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. Speaker, I think I can clarify this for Senator Cullan. Senator Schmit's amendment deals with a constituent in his district who happens to border mine with a big game farm. It deals with a provision of law which we already passed and been signed into law, LB 435. It would exempt a big game farm from the provisions of 435. That's all it does. And I...all my amendment to the Schmit amendment is is a severability clause, because I have some questions as to it being germane.
