SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we're in the middle of a vote. We have to take the vote. What's your pleasure? Do you want to move the....

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will announce the vote first.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 12 nays on adoption of Senator Brennan's amendment.
