LB 585, 587

Senator Chambers, Senator Venditte, Senator Labeledz. Okay will the legislators please take their seats. The Chair would operate with the intention of keeping the House under Call until we complete a short number of amendments that we have so we don't have to keep jumping back and forth. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call commenced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hold the Call. All legislators must be in their seats when we are under Call. Otherwise we cannot proceed with the business. Okay, proceed.

CLERK: Roll call continued on vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The legislators will please be in their seats. If the legislators...hold up on the Call. Don't announce the vote until all legislators are in their seats. Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Are there any other motions on LB 595....the House is under Call. All legislators please keep in their seats. Are there any other motions on LB 595, sorry, 585? Are there others?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, do you wish to advance the bill? Okay, I am sorry. We go to the next, the next bill is LB 587. We are going to take up LB 587, 589, 594, 596 and 591. There are roughly four amendments on all these bills. Now I would appreciate leaving the House under Call until we get this done. LB 587.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senator Haberman on LB 587 but I understand he is considering withdrawing that motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, fellow colleagues, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If there is no objection, so ordered. Any other amendments on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on LB 587, Mr. President.
