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have had to shore up our fire protection so \$100,000 of this would simply be for smoke detection and communication systems. We have already done that on one floor to make more legislative space available. We have gone up to the tower and done some of those things. It calls for \$225,000 for interior space rehabilitation and then \$25,000 for moving and relocating. We are going to have to meet our legitimate space needs and it is our judgment and it is the judgment on the part of the administrative services, the Governor's judgment, that this will be an easy way to do it. The price of it is \$350,000. I move the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Lewis, would you give us a rundown quickly as to what the situation is on the Midwest Life building, if we are going to do this

SENATOR LEWIS: I would be happy to do that. As you know we had that in progress last year. You served on the committee. We took it out to appraisal and then we took it to the Governor and said do you want to buy the building? And his response was, no. He said you guys can if you want to and I said, no, I would not support any move to buy that building unless the Governor came in with the recommendation for it. So that's...

SENATOR NICHOL: Another question is, are we going to forget about the Midwest Life building?

SENATOR LEWIS: It would be my judgment until the administration comes forward and says they have those kind of space needs, yes.

SENATOR NICHOL: All right. Thanks.

SENATOR LEWIS: And this is, may I, Mr. President, explain one more thing? The Board cut back some of the renovation that was planned for this year because we did not think that was consistent with what we ought to do. One of those we cut back was the building of two additional restrooms right back here in the locker room and tearing out the old restroom and that was for \$550,000. This is to upgrade the existing space we have. No alterations, no additional inclusions, it simply let's take advantage of the space we have, get it fire safe and rehabilitate it and move people and use the space we have got available. I move my amendment.
