SENATOR MURPHY: Just a quick question of Senator Lewis. Senator Lewis, are you telling me we are spending this kind of money to put smoke detectors in that new restroom?

SENATOR LEWIS: No, sir.

SENATOR MURPHY: Oh.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return LB 594 to Select File for the specific amendment as explained by Senator Lewis. All in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Motion is on the return of the bill. Record the vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill has been returned. Now we move the...

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, LB 594.

SENATOR WESELY: I move that LB 594 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Bring up the next motion on LB 594, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner moves to return LB 594 to Select File for specific amendment. Would you like me to read it, Senator?

SENATOR WARNER: Is that the two page one?

CLERK: Yes, sir, a page and a half.
