That's the technical motion. So a motion to return for the DeCamp amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The House is under Call. What do you wish to do, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, I just....

PRESIDENT: Here comes Senator Lewis.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I think Senator Lewis ought to be afforded an opportunity to vote.

PRESIDENT: Alright, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 20 nays to return the bill to Select File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is returned to Select File. We're now ready for the action on the motion. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well I move the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the motion now is to adopt the amendment. Is there discussion? Senator Lewis, did you wish to speak to the motion? Senator Nichol, do you wish to speak to the motion?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I just have a question. The chiller's been in and out, and in and out. I wonder whether it's in....I think it's in now and I wonder if this motion took it out or left it in.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, would you answer that question?

SENATOR DeCAMP: The famed chiller is out, and if you want to do the chiller, do the chiller separate. That's the way I did this.

SENATOR NICHOL: Your amendment doesn't touch the chiller?

SENATOR DeCAMP: It takes the chiller out which was recently put in.
