believe Senator Warner one hundred percent sitting on the Appropriations Committee that it will trigger a tax increase, and so be it. We are shifting from sales and income to....or from property to sales and income, and that's fine. But if we're going to do it let's use the whole half a percent of the tax increase we're going to trigger and let's use it this year and let's put it where we all want it, to schools and a property tax relief. My amendment raises this amount from \$10,000,000 to \$35,000,000, and it will take up the whole half a percent of the tax increase we're going to trigger. Let's not leave \$25,000,000 on the table to be spent indiscriminately next session. Let's take this \$25,000,000 that we're going to have to raise from this tax increase, put it into schools, put it into schools on a per head basis just like the DeCamp amendment has done and really get our money's worth. I'm sure Senator Schmit will be able to support this, very eloquently talked about getting money to those schools and those teachers and for the benefit of those children and I concur. But let's not fool around with \$30.00 a head. We're going to raise the sales tax a half a percent. Let's not do it for \$30.00 a student. Let's get it up to \$105.00 a student and let's give property some meaningful relief. Let's not kid the people and go home and say, hey look at what I've done to your property tax. Let's put this up to an amount where it is going to be significant, where it's going to have an impact, where those property taxpayers are going to get some tangible positive relief, and we can do this with my amendment, and it isn't going to cost us any more political pressure than the \$10,000,000 you just spent, because the \$10,000,000 is going to trigger the tax increase. We're either going to leave \$25,000,000 on the table, or we're going to put that \$25,000,000 to work in schools and for the benefit of property tax payers. I strongly urge the adoption of this amendment and I'm dead serious about this. This is not a frivolous type amendment. I'm willing to stand behind this and back this all the way across the floor of this Legislature and all the way across or all the way over the Governor's....which I think would be a probable veto, but let's not kid around. If we're going to trigger a tax increase, which we have done, let's spend the whole amount we triggered and put it to where we intend it to go. I'd strongly urge the adoption of this amendment.
