SENATOR SIMON: Well, I see forty-six ayes and two not voting and that totals forty-eight. Did somebody lose a seat in the Legislature? We used to have forty-nine Senators. Did somebody pass away or something that I didn't know about? It totals forty-eight on the board.

PRESIDENT: I don't plan on trying to argue with the computer, you know...

SENATOR SIMON: (inaudible)

PRESIDENT: (interruption)...I'm just checking on who is here and who is not here. Senator Nichol, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, Johnny can't read and add and maybe the computer can't either, so....

PRESIDENT: That's very possible. That's very possible. Senator Clark is now here. Senator Clark, have you...

SENATOR CLARK: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Alright, now it shows....

SENATOR CULLAN: Roll call. I would ask for a roll call and ask the Clerk to explain what the amendment is factually.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Alright, will you explain what we're voting on? Everybody is here now. The House is still under Call, and we will have the motion read and then a roll call vote. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, Senator Cullan moves to return LB 585 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment would add \$25,000,000 to the Committee level, and add \$15,000,000 to the DeCamp amendment which we previously adopted.

PRESIDENT: Okay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was taken which may be found on Page 1951 of the Legislative Journal.) 14 ayes, 31 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Alright, now, any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the Appropriation bills.
