Okay, do you want to advance the bill and then we will bring it back, Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, I move that LB 571 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move that LB 571 be returned for a specific amendment. The amendment just merely changes one word and adds a new section that defines the time that the act becomes operative because of the tax collection process that has to become operative on the first of the month rather than ninety days from the close of the session.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any other questions? The motion is to bring the bill back to Select File for the specific amendment as explained by Senator Schmit. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed no. Senator Fitzgerald, do you wish to be recognized after this motion or now?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: After.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned and the motion is to adopt the amendment. Senator Fitzgerald, do you wish to talk on that motion?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Mr. Speaker, I would like to ask Senator Schmit a question. How this money is going to be distributed, the one cent gasoline tax? Did you put a motion in from your second motion? This will be your third motion to correct that situation that we talked about, Senator?
