SENATOR FITZGERALD: Have you got that motion in all ready, Senator, or...

SENATOR SCHMIT: That motion is in the Journal. It is on page 1978, I believe, of the Journal, Senator Fitzgerald. It will come up next.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the adoption of the Schmit amendment to LB 571 vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Schmit, do you want to move the bill back?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be returned, Mr. President, for the specific amendment found on page 1958 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well first of all we have to return it to E & R...

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be readvanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: ...E & R engrossment, yes. All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Now, Mr. Clerk, do you have another amendment to 571?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to return LB 571 to Select File for a specific amendment.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I believe that Senator Warner is going to withdraw that amendment. I have virtually the same amendment but he want to...

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment is technical I guess in nature but what it does is because the section that is being amended also affects the pledge that the state has made to highway bonds already issued and still in effect which were pledged, the receipts in the trust fund from that portion of the sales tax were pledged irrevocably to the retirement of that debt and the amendment makes it very clear that the additional one cent that Senator Schmit has in 571 is separate and
