SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, is there objection to Senator Warner withdrawing his proposed amendment to 571? If not, so ordered. Senator Schmit, do you have any additional comments on your motion now to bring the bill back?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Not at this time, Mr. President, except to say that Senator Warner has already explained my amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, the motion is to bring 571 back to Select File for the specific amendment as discussed by Senator Warner and Senator Schmit. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is returned. Now, Senator Schmit, do you move the adoption of the amendment?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.
