SENATOR DeCAMP: Well it would seem that these concerns could have been registered slightly prior to this. Now I have had those amendments checked out by the chief of police in Omaha and by the city prosecutor in Omaha and I know that there has been some correspondence to legislators from officials in Lancaster County essentially approving what Senator DeCamp published on page 1883 and I have no objection to that but these amendments he is advancing today have not been published. He didn't show them to me. I have no idea what they say and I would ask Senator DeCamp either that we move the amendments on page 1883, which I have already cleared with the law enforcement officers to which they grudgingly agree or hold this over a day so they can be consulted about his most recent set of amendments.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Did he ask a question?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, he asked unanimous consent that the bill be held one day.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Then I object.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hoagland, there is objection to your motion. I think you asked unanimous consent to hold the bill up for a day.
