SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1964-1965 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Hoagland motion to hold the bill over for one day.

CLERK: (Continued reading roll call vote.) 26 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carries. The bill is held over for one day. Go to LB 569. Before you do that I have two sets of guests to introduce. One is in the South balcony from Senator Murphy's district, thirty eighth graders, one teacher and eight parents from St. Michael Elementary School, South Sioux City, Nebraska. Linda Ebel is the eighth grade teacher. Are you still up there? If you are hold up your hands. And the other group from Senator Koch's district, sixty-five fourth graders, three teachers, nine parents from Paddock Elementary School, Omaha, Nebraska, and Gary Hansum is the teacher leader. Where are you? Hold up your hands so we can see where you are. Welcome. Next item is 569, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Wesely, Landis and Newell move to return LB 569 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is found on page 1885 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Landis. Who were the other two? Senator Newell, do you wish to be recognized on the motion?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes. Mr. President, the Secretary of State caught something in the process of doing the last amendment that Senator Wesely and Senator Landis offered. Basically the problem is this, is that on the uncommitted delegates there could easily be some confusion as to when they choose to vote for any of the names like Kennedy, whatever they might be on the all star primary. They also have a list of uncommitted delegates which can be very confusing and for that reason this is to strike "delegates" so that there will not be any confusion so it is clear that it is uncommitted, that they are uncommitted and they are voting for an uncommitted candidate on the all star presidential or not for any of the other candidates on the all star presidential primary. I will give the remainder of my time to Senator Landis.
