SENATOR CLARK: A Call of the House has been requested. Those in favor of a Call of the House vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SENATOR CLARK: The House is under Call. All legislators will take their seats. Unauthorized personnel will leave the floor. Everyone record in, please.
