again indicate... I am looking at amendments to LB 363, Request #2919. Is that what you have?

SENATOR CULLAN: That is correct.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, now where did you propose to divide?

SENATOR CULLAN: Okay, the division of the question, the first items that would be discussed would be the items establishing a council, a coordinating council. That would include #2 on here and then all of the sections beginning with section 6 on page 3 to the end of the bill and I believe that is the language that is appropriate. At any rate, the intent is to have that language which relates to establishing a council to be divided out initially. The next item which would be considered would be the language starting with, in line 19 on page 1, through line 11 on page 3. That would be the second question and then the third question would be the remaining parts of the Koch amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now let me go over it once more. You propose to divide it three places?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: And the first place is on page 1, it starts with line 3 and goes through what? Line 14?

SENATOR CULLAN: Yes, that is correct and then included with that would be beginning with section 6 on page 3 through the remainder of the bill, as I understand it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair looks first of all to Senator Koch. Senator Koch, do you have a comment? I am having a little difficulty putting these pieces together.

SENATOR KOCH: As I understand...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you in agreement...?

SENATOR KOCH: I understand Senator Cullan. Basically what I am offering is three distinct amendments and Senator Cullan is trying to get rid of the council. So if we make that decision up or down, that would be one amendment that either stays or goes. It deals with the council and it is a rather substantial body of the amendment itself and he is evidently saying that is the first thing that he wants to deal with.
