to you now may be more controversial but in my opinion it is a necessary amendment. If you look at Senator Koch's language and the language which we adopted in the Koch amendments which are now the committee amendments, on page 4, in line 1, or you look at that particular section which is section 7, it says, and I will read it to you: Each member of the council shall be paid a per diem of \$25.00 per day for each day actually and necessarily spent in attending to his or her duties as a member of such council and shall be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses including mileage as provided in sections 84-306.01 revised statute supplement, 1978. In this particular amendment, if you will follow me on page 4, line 1, strike "and necessarily spent" and insert...strike... just a minute...on page 4, line 1, strike beginning with "and" through "in" in line 1, and strike beginning with "to" in line 1 through "and" in line 2. Yes it was. Oh, I am sorry. Mr. President, this is out of order. I apologize. That was to a portion of the Koch amendment that was not adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor... The question has been called for. There are no other lights on so I think we will just proceed. All those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendments as amended to 363 vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The amendments are adopted. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move to advance LB 363 as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the advancement of the bill vote aye, opposed no. Record. Will the legislators please go to their seats. We are going to dig up Final Reading.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have any items to read in? Look at the bottom of your agenda. Okay, go ahead. There is 363A that we need to advance.
