LB 585, 582, 583

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, since it was my amendment and did involve more than a trifling sum, \$9,999,999, and since it is such a major thing, I would go along with this. I think it is something we should handle this way unless Senator Dworak would just want to change his vote here real quick. Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the issue will be revoted upon on Monday at the same time that LB 585 would be considered on Final Reading. Now before we proceed with Final Reading, item #6, in the South balcony from Senator Landis' District, it is my privilege to introduce 45 fourth and fifth graders, two teachers, two parents from Havelock Elementary School, Lincoln, Sue Dauer, the fourth grade teacher, and you should be in the South balcony. Would you indicate just by holding up your hands where you are located? Now if all legislators are in their seats, we will proceed with item #6 on the agenda today which is Final Reading. All legislators please be in their seats. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 582.

CLERK: Read LB 582 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 582 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2017, Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Before we go to the next bill, in the South balcony from Senator Schmit's District, I wish to introduce 28 kindergarten through eighth grade students, two teachers and six parents from District 61, 75, Malmo and Cedar Bluffs and the teacher is Bonnie Roberts. You should be located in the South balcony. Will you raise your hands so we can say hello to you? On Final Reading the Clerk will read LB 583.

CLERK: Read LB 583 on Final Reading.
