LB 588, 593, 224

Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2020, Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting and 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 593.

CLERK: Read LB 593 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 2020 and 2021, Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 2 nays, 1 excused and not voting and 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. While we are waiting to advance some bills off of Select File which will help with our workload, I want to introduce once again from Senator Kremer's District 27 third and fourth grade students, two teachers and five parents from Clark's, Nebraska Elementary School and Dorla Lindburg is the third grade teacher. At the time this came up they were in the South balcony. Now, Senator Wesely, we have a list of these. The first one is LB 224.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 224.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. The E & R amendments are adopted.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 224 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Now we have got to bring that bill back to attach the emergency clause. Do you so move?
