SPEAKER MARVEL: But the Chair rules that the amendment is not germane.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, that makes it inconvenient.

SPEAKER MARVEL: So it is your opportunity to overrule the Chair. It is a complete rewrite of the bill.

SENATOR DeCAMP: That is true.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I haven't had a chance to look it over as thoroughly as I'd like but it is a complete rewrite of the bill and I understand what you are trying to do. I have no choice but to rule it ungermane. It is not germane.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, proceed. Let's see, Senator Hoagland, are you ready to vote on your amendment?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, I am, Mr. Speaker, and I will waive closing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Hoagland second amendment. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Hoagland amendment number two. The House is still under Call. Please vote.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: We are still under Call, aren't we?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, the House is still under Call.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would ask for a roll call vote, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 2038, Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Next the Cullan amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cullan moves to indefinitely postpone LB 382. Mr. President, because we are on Select File, that would lay the bill over. Senator Venditte moves to suspend Rule 7, Sec. 3 so as to take up the indefinitely postpone motion today.
