SENATOR DE CAMP: To see my answer to the question. The answer, the answer is, yes. I think he...

SENATOR KEYES: You couldn't be looking for Walt Radcliffe could you? There would be the answer that I would have to oppose.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Actually there is a series there is four of them, they consult and they give me some....

SENATOR KEYES: Well Johnny you are smarter than I am and the law especially and.....

SENATOR DE CAMP: Yes, but I didn't write 285.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry, but we can't continue this dialogue. Senator Keyes, do you have a question?

SENATOR KEYES: In your own mind Senator DeCamp and I think that you can hear me, and if you can't hear me I'll talk louder. I can bellow. In your own mind this will do exactly what we have being done under LB 1. With the...as it pertains to bonded indebtedness. It is not under the lid bill, it is not under the 7%, it isn't a part of it, it can go anyplace that it wants to and you can levy any millage you want to to pay off the bonded indebtedness.

SENATOR DE CAMP: It was a unanimous vote on it yes.

SENATOR KEYES: Then I want my good friends to know that one amendment on that bill I will support. I'm sorry I didn't see this before the ten seconds before you sprung it on us but I have a suspicion about this bill and it is not good.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, we are speaking to the De Camp amendments.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'm going to speak in support of the DeCamp amendment and I would just like to say briefly what I think is happening here. Basically, with the committee amendment you have a provision, a Section C which when added to A & B excludes theoretically and hopefully in the minds of those that drafted I believe, all types of bonded indebtedness. I think what has happened is that whoever drafted Section C or whoever reviewed who drafted Section C fears that maybe one or two types of bonded indebtedness may have not been included because somewhat specific language is used, such as paving and other street improvement districts or sewer and water
