Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, this is a tax bill and I figure that it is probably one of the most important pieces of legislation that we will pass this year. I want a Call of the House and a roll call vote. I would like to have everybody that is in calling distance get in here. This is a record.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clear the board, Mr. Clerk. Question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Shall the House go under Call is the question. Do you want to proceed with the roll call?

SENATOR KEYES: Well I would like to have a roll call vote to see if we go under Call or not. I think that this is important enough. I'll withdraw the roll call vote, it looks very nice.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 15 nays to go under Call Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Legislature is under Call. All legislators please return to their seats and record your presence. Senator Landis, Senator Koch, Senator Warner, Senator George, Senator Cope, Senator Fowler, Senator Beutler, Senator Kahle, Senator Dworak, Senator Cullan, Senator Brennan, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell, Senator Simon, Senator Hoagland, Senator Lewis, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly. Senator Cope would you record your presence please. Senator Newell would you record your presence please? Senator Dworak would you record your presence please? Senator Cullan, yes, you are here. Senator Koch would you record your presence? Senator Chambers would you record your presence. Do you want to proceed with the roll call Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: You mean that we have seven people that are excused on this important issue and this late in the session? Five. How many are excused?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Two.
