SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we are speaking to that motion. Senator Fowler, do you wish to be recognized? Senator DeCamp, your light is on.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, there have been so many kill attempts. One more won't hurt I guess. I agree to suspend the Rules and take it up immediately so we don't have to wait around, like he wants.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to suspend the Rules to take up the kill motion. Is that the motion? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. The motion before the House is the suspension of the Rules to take up Senator Cullan's kill motion on LB 120. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay to suspend the Rules, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Rules have been suspended. The Chair recognizes Senator Cullan.
