SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SENATOR CULLAN: Thank you so much, Senator DeCamp. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this bill changes so often it is really difficult to know what is in it but one thing we do know because Senator DeCamp just told us, it does create a new tax, and I do not believe that the people of the State of Nebraska want a new tax for a litter program that isn't going to do, in my opinion, much to solve the litter problem. That is about all that I really need to say and I hope that you will vote to indefinitely postpone this bill and that we will not create another new tax for another new purpose.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? The motion is, shall debate cease? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 6 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. Senator Cullan. Okay, the motion is the indefinite postponement of LB 120. Those in favor of indefinite postponement vote aye, opposed to postponement vote no. Have you all voted? The motion is the indefinite postponement. Have you all voted? Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: How many are excused, Mr. President? Well, let's let it go.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. What is the next motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to suspend Rule 6, section 4 and Rule 7, section 3 and vote on advancement without further amendment or debate.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I think I have been more than sporting about this as we have marched along on this bill for about three years now. I am just trying to avoid the situation where there would be another four hundred amendments to tax dog tails and everything else you could think about and stall around another three years. All I am asking you to do, whether you are for or against the bill, is just let me have a vote on advancing it. I succumbed a few minutes ago to let him have a kill right now. I didn't
