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try to beg off or anything. All I am asking is reciprocation. If you are against the bill, fine. At least give it a fair shot. Let those that want to vote on it vote on the merits or lack thereof of the bill and that is it. That is all the motion is to let us vote. I think that is only fair and I gave in to the other guys on it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler, do you wish to speak on this motion?

SENATOR FOWLER: I guess I wanted at some time to talk about the new bill that was just introduced on Select File and we have not really had a full explanation of what the latest draft is, what it does, how much revenue it raises. We have had a fiscal note handed out that I think says that the amount of revenue has been cut in half from the previous bill. Now I could understand Senator DeCamp wishing to suspend the rules and move the bill across if this was the same bill that was introduced on General File the first or second time he introduced bills on General File or if it was the bill that was introduced originally but this is the fourth or fifth litter bill. Senator DeCamp effectively plays the martyr saying, golly, you fellows have debated this out and attacked this and harassed me but the fact of the matter is that it is Senator DeCamp that keeps amending this bill, Senator DeCamp that keeps giving us a new bill, Senator DeCamp that when he presented the amendments didn't really explain what the new bill was, just says, hey, fellows, I am handing some stuff out. This will explain it all. We can all vote. I call the question. I think that Senator DeCamp owes this body the courtesy of letting us debate his new bill. Now I could understand that if he had not amended it, if he had not changed it, if he had not changed the nature of the tax, if he had not reduced the amount of revenue, as it appears he has done, then perhaps he would have a legitimate argument but I really think that we should have a chance to really understand what is the nature of the new tax, the new taxing system, before we advance this to Final Reading so I would oppose the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, colleagues, I am strongly opposed to this tactic and always have been. We didn't do this for the laetrile people earlier. There is a lot of people who would like to have a bill put across without any debate, without any enlightenment. I think it is poor legislative policy. I think this Legislature has not subdued
