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itself to this type of policy this session. I think this has been one of the openest sessions we have had, and I think to commence on this type of tactic and procedure at this point is absolutely wrong. I think that we create a lot of public mistrust when we do this type of thing and I think we are not fair to ourselves. I am as sick of this bill as anybody else. I have heard versions of this bill for five years and now we have got a new draft, a promised new draft that Senator DeCamp put out in front of us and nobody has even explained it, nobody has even talked about it. It has not even been discussed. Now I think Senator DeCamp to try and pull the wool over our eyes and shoot this across the floor of the Legislature without getting into the details of this bill is absolutely a mistake. Now if this draft were so darn perfect that this bill did not need to be debated and did not need to go under the scrutiny of the Legislature, why did Senator DeCamp agree to Senator Koch's motion. Obviously the bill wasn't perfect. Obviously there was a flaw in it. Obviously Senator Koch found that flaw and brought it up, brought it before this body and this body seen fit to adopt that particular amendment. I do not think that this bill should go across without some kind of debate, without some kind of debate. Now remember, Senator DeCamp is the one that said he was going to totally rework this bill. We have got a fiscal note that is significantly different. We have got administration ramifications that are significantly different obviously as reflected by the fiscal note. I think these things need to be pointed out. I think they need to be explained. I think they need to be debated. I think members of this body need to know what is in this bill and also the people that we represent need to have this knowledge also to decide and to determine what we are doing is in their best interest. I strongly oppose this rule suspension.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy, then Senator Chambers.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, I guess I would have liked an explanation of Senator DeCamp about what this newest gimmick is. The question was put and the vote was taken before I received the material that was being handed out and that, of course, makes for a fine legislative decision but I still don't know who is going to collect this fee or who is going to be responsible for it or who is going to administer it. I think we have just engaged in one of the most foul adoptions of an amendment on this floor that I have ever seen. The Pages are still handing out the amendment and the vote has been recorded. Now we are getting a little silly in our old age and I am getting pretty old but I certainly am not
