LB 587

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Newell amendment to LB 587. All those in favor...I am sorry, the motion is to return to Select File for the purpose of adopting Senator Newell's amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? I will call for the vote once more. Have you all voted? Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, I would ask for a roll call so that everyone can be reported (interruption).

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are five excused.

SENATOR NEWELL: I still think a roll call would let everybody have an opportunity to be on record.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, roll call is requested. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 2071, Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Before we proceed with Final Reading, I would like to introduce first of all in the South balcony from Senator Sieck's District 25 fourth graders, one teacher, six mothers, from Willard Elementary School, York, Nebraska, Mrs. Verna Wolfe, the teacher. Where are you located? Will you hold up your hand so we can...okay? Also in the South balcony from Senator Simon's District 18 first through sixth graders, two teachers, one parent, from District #27 which is east and north of Elkhorn, Nebraska, Luella Hahn, the teacher. Where are you located? Raise your hands. We welcome you today. And finally in the North balcony from both Senator Schmit's and Senator Dworak's Districts 47 fourth graders, two teachers, eight mothers from St. Bonaventure Elementary School, Columbus, Nebraska, Mrs. Cary Raesner, the teacher. Where are you located? I would like to caution you to please don't lean on the balcony on the partition up there because we would hate to see you tumble off. We appreciate you all coming. We welcome you. Now the Clerk will read LB 587 on Final Reading.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 587 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is LB 587 on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.
