LB 587, 589

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2072, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. The next bill, but before we start the next bill, what I would like to do with the approval of the Legislature is just to proceed, after we finish Final Reading, proceed with Select File, and then when we get through, adjourn. The next bill, LB 589.

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all, we need to suspend Rule 6, Sec. 6b and take up LB 589 on Final Reading today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the suspension of the rules to read LB 589E, 589E. All those in favor of that motion to suspend the rules so we can read the bill vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. The rules are suspended.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell now moves to return LB 589 to Select File for specific amendment, the amendment being: On page 77, line 1, strike the word "professional".

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, there are a number of people gone today, and for that reason since the similar issue was defeated on the other bill, I would save this body some time by conceding this issue and withdrawing this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you ask unanimous consent to withdraw the amendment? Okay, so ordered. The Clerk will read on Final Reading, LB 589E.

CLERK: Read LB 589 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on LB 589 on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.
