SENATOR DeCAMP: I would ask for a Call of the House, a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch is voting aye. Senator Koch, do you want to punch your button please? I will call for the vote once more and then I will turn it over to you. Have you all voted on the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 398? That is the issue before the House. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: A call of the House, roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is, shall the House go under Call? All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 14 ayes, and 1 nay, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Are all legislators in your seats and have you recorded your presence? Then the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes and the call in vote would be on the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 398. The Clerk is authorized to accept call in votes.

CLERK: Senator Hefner voting aye. Senator Nichol changing from no to yes. Senator Reutzel changing from no to yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 7 nays on the adoption of the E & R amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. The motion now is the advancement of the bill. Is that your motion, Senator DeCamp? Okay, the motion is to advance....

SENATOR DeCAMP: No, that is not my motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, there obviously are not enough votes here to advance any bill on Select. I have another motion up there. If we are going to use this process of E & R obstruction, using E & R as a process for stopping the whole process, there is no use in being around here this afternoon. Anybody can just take over
