LB 585

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have is to return LB 585 to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator Keyes moves to return it and the amendment is found on page 2014 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, could I ask a question of the Chair? Senator Marvel, Senator Schmit is one of the prime movers in gasohol in this state and he is on his way in. I was just wondering if we could take 585 and put it behind 596 E, which is another appropriation bill and it will just be held a few minutes. He will be here by that time. I understand one of his cows is having a calf and the calf is worth \$250 when it shakes its head and he just had to be there to see it shake.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Let me... Senator Keyes, I'm not certain of your question but let me try to answer it as I understand it. If you will check the agenda...let's see, we have finished with 141. There are four appropriation bills and there are amendments to these bills.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay now, the amendments have to be processed and the bills have to be returned to E & R for engrossment...

SENATOR KEYES: Yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: ...yet today and if this is not done then we cannot proceed with the rest of Final Reading which has to do with A bills. Now Senator Warner can go more into detail on this if he would like but I am not sure what you are asking.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, what I am asking is that 585 follow 596. It will get it in the same day and everything else. It will just give time for Senator Schmit to arrive. That is all.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Let me ask Senator Warner a question. Senator Warner, Senator Keyes was asking unanimous consent that 585 follow 596. What does this do to the procedure, not only in the processing of appropriations bills but also the eventual release of the other bills each of which has an A bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I assume it could follow 594. That is a money bill. Mr. President, as I thought the things
