SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would like to call the question, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I understood the Clerk to say it was Section 38 but Senator Koch was talking about the Eppley Building which I believe is Section 37. Which was it?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: I'm sorry, I wasn't listening to the Clerk. I handed him up there Section 37 first, then 38. That is the second motion.

SENATOR LAMB: So which one are we talking about?

CLERK: Senator Koch prefers Section 37. That is the one we are dealing with, Senator.

SENATOR KOCH: Section 37 was my first amendment.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to read the...?

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to return LB 594 to Select File to strike Section 37, Program 906.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, now the question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay. The question is, shall debate cease. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Koch is recognized to close on his motion.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I apologize to you and the members of the body. I was assuming it was Section 37, The Eppley facility at the UNO campus. I have been on that campus as much as anyone has in recent years in terms of looking at facilities. That library is not in as bad a shape as we think it is particularly since we have added new facilities in recent years. Again, this is in my community, the area from which I come. I think this is the opportunity for you to make a determination whether or not that is a top priority. I ask for the adoption of the amendment.
