LB 594

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return LB 594 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The bill has to be returned. Senator Koch. Have you all voted? Senator Koch. There are five aye. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 24 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Clerk, read the next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to return LB 594 to Select File for specific amendment, that amendment being to strike Section 38, Program 924.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I won't bore you. This is a significant amount of money as well which over the next several years is going to amount to several millions of dollars. I ask to return 594 to Select File for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol, your light is on. Do you wish to...? Senator DeCamp, your light is on. Okay. The motion before the House is the return of 924, 594, sorry, for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, how many are absent?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Five.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I would like to have a roll call vote for our attendance record.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, a roll call vote has been... Do you want to clear the board? Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 2096 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 24 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Are you ready to go to 585 now? The Clerk will read some items into the record and then we will go to 585.
