done. Secondly, it is my understanding at least, Senator Wesely, that the possibility is there that the Commission or Aging could use, they have a variety of federal funds that may mean some reallocation or redirecting of their receipts but I had understood that they probably could pick some of this up if not all of it if they chose to do so but it would obviously mean some reallocation on their part. Whether the fact that the Governor was correct in making this kind of an allocation is one issue but I don't think, if it was an error, I don't think we ought to correct it by replacing the \$72,000 with general fund money and I would urge the body to reject the motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay. Shall debate cease?

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate is ceased. Senator Wesely, do you want to close on your amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I would just add in following up on the comments by Senator Warner, I don't like to cover for the mistakes made by the Governor either and I would hope that he would change his mind but he is not going to and as a result we are going to be putting out of work a number of citizens who have been able to make meaningful contributions to our cities and I think that it would be a mistake to allow those programs to die as a result so I ask for your support of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to bring the bill back for the specific amendment as discussed by Senator Wesely. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Are you ready to record the vote? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Are there any other amendments on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, sir. I have one final one. Senator DeCamp moves to return LB 585 to Select File for a specific amendment to strike the DeCamp amendment printed on page 1947 of the Journal.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Do you want to do it now? It is up to you, whatever you want.
