SPEAKER MARVEL: Are all Legislators in their seats?
Senator Lamb.

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting no. Senator Beutler voting aye.
Senator Carsten changing from yes to no. Senator.....

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the advancement of 345 to
E & R for Engrossment.

CLERK: Senator Koch voting no. Senator Fowler voting aye.
Senator Clark voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted.

CLERK: Senator Haberman voting...changing from no to yes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, what is your pleasure?

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, there has only been one
excused, is that correct?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir. Senator Schmit, will you record
your presence please. Senator Hefner, Senator Goodrich,
Senator Hefner, Senator Goodrich and Senator Venditte.

SENATOR NEWELL: Go ahead, would you call the roll please?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 25 ayes, 20 nays, 1 excused and not
voting, 3 present and not voting. Vote appears on page 2138
of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion passed, bill is advanced. Next item
will be 321.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 321 was returned from Final Reading
to Select File for a specific amendment. That amendment is
now pending and is on page 1614 of the Legislative Journal.
