LB 120A

CLERK: Mr. President, there is an A bill on 120. There are no E & R amendments but Senator DeCamp himself has amendments pending to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, the A bill now with the amendment would conform to the much lower cost by using the other system of a licensing system, just doing it annually instead of going on the computer and running it like a tax four times a year so I move adoption of the amendment. As I say, it dramatically cuts the cost of operation while maintaining the same amount of revenue.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Your motion is to amend 120A? Senator Haberman, your light is on.

SENATOR HABERMAN: May I ask Senator DeCamp a question?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you yield?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: What is the total amount of the A bill now?

SENATOR DeCAMP: What is it, Patrick?

CLERK: One hundred thirty-three thousand seven hundred... Strike "one hundred thirty-three thousand seven hundred fifty" and "insert one hundred thousand".

SENATOR HABERMAN: \$100,000?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mmm hmm. That is the first year to set it all up. In two or three years it will be considerably less.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment to LB 120A. All those in favor of that amendment vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment.
