SENATOR HABERMAN: Chair...

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: May I have a question of Senator Warner, please? Senator Warner, your sheet shows \$318,000 as the cost of this, but then in the next paragraph it mentions another \$295,000. Which is correct?

SENATOR WARNER: The appropriations in...is...part of that appropriation for the council of government was in 585 which is \$124,000. The note down at the bottom should show the appropriations would be 589 and also 585. There is no change in dollars.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Then you're saying the total cost would be \$318,000 like on your green sheet?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, and that's what is in...that's the total of the appropriations otherwise.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Plus \$609,000 federal dollars?

SENATOR WARNER: Right. But that's all passed through... yes, that's correct, it doesn't....it's not operational money.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Where are we now? Okay. All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? We're talking about LB 412A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote taken as found on Pages 2153 and 2154 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 11 nays, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with the bill passes with emergency clause attached. Now we will revert for a moment to 505E and then we will go back to 444. The Clerk will read 505E on Final Reading.
