SENATOR KEYES: How many votes, Senator Marvel, does this bill take?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thirty.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title to LB 506.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of the law having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.
