I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. Shall debate cease is the question before the House. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, debate is ceased. Are we ready now to....Senator Kremer, do you have any closing?

SENATOR KREMER: No closing. I said I would not debate it. I would only give the reason why I bring this motion up at this time. No closing.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk will read the motion again.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to suspend Rule 1, Section 16, Rule 6, Section 2 and Rule 7, Section 3(a) so as to vote on the advancement of LB 221 to E & R Initial without further debate or amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. It takes thirty votes. Have you all voted? Record vote has been requested. Have you all voted? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to settle this once and for all this session so I'm going to ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: A Call of the House has been requested. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. One excused, Senator Cullan. Senator Sieck, will you record your presence, please? Senator Warner, Senator George, Senator Rumery, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Frank Lewis, Senator Kelly. Senator Simon, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. President, I just....I have a question of the Chair. If this motion....we would have two...we would vote twice, correct? We would vote first to suspend the rules and then on the advancement? This motion is to suspend the rules, and the next motion would be for the advancement of the bill. Alright, if this motion
