SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, in great respect, if you want to use 363A for a cure at Central I'll allow you to use it. Otherwise we can just leave it where it is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You don't want the bill advanced?

SENATOR KOCH: Well, I was talking to Senator Warner a moment ago. Senator Warner, did you advise me we should leave 363A (sic) on Select? He advised we can leave it there if Senator DeCamp needs it for some later...oh, well, we'll just leave it on Select for the time being, I'm being advised by various people....

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, if there are no objections we'll pass over 363A. We now go to LB 479. Mr. Clerk.
