LB 363, 363A, 597

SENATOR NICHOL: Well what I'm saying is, you say if they're not printed...what I took up to the Clerk this morning was printed, but it wasn't printed by the computer I guess.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, all I can tell you is within a few minutes Emory will have those motions up here, because I asked him to give us a list so that we could see exactly where were.

SENATOR NICHOL: Now, my other question is, we have a bill, 597, that we put into 363A, and that's printed and up on the Clerk's desk. Does that mean that can go or can't go? It's all printed up in the correct form.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I guess I'm going to have to repeat what I said and hedge until Emory gets his list up here, and then we can indicate to you whether it's ready to go or not.

SENATOR NICHOL: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We're captives of....

SENATOR NICHOL: Emery.

SPEAKER MARVEL: ....of the second or third industrial revolution.

PRESIDENT: We're ready then for Agenda Item #5 on motions, commencing then with LB 5.....wait a minute, you want to take up that....Senator Wesely...Senator Wesely, we have a matter to advance here. LB 363 has some amendments to adopt and send forward. The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 363.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 363. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments on LB 363 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 363 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion to advance LB 363 to E & R for Engrossment.
