CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. Sergeant at Arms will bring in all the members of the Legislature. All nonlegislative personnel leave the floor. All members of the Legislature record your presence. Senator Haberman, are you here? Yes. Thank you. Senator Marvel. Senator Cope. Senator Reutzel is here, yes. Senator DeCamp. Senator Venditte is not here. Senator Beutler is here. There's Senator Beutler. He's here. All right, they're all here now. Senator Pirsch said she will accept call-in votes. Anybody want to vote?

CLERK: Senator Fowler voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burrows is back, here's....Senator Burrows.

CLERK: Senator Burrows voting...still voting no.

PRESIDENT: Senator Pirsch, do you wish to have a roll call vote at this point then? All right. We will have a roll call vote. All members be at their desks. The House is under Call. Senator Pirsch, do you wish us to proceed? Senator Venditte I think is the only one not here, so we will proceed. Proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: (Roll call vote was taken which may be found on Page 2203 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 21 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Well, yes you can but we'll probably just have to call it right back in, but the motion is to raise the Call. No objections. So ordered. The Call is raised. Proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with LB 42.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to return LB 42 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is found on Page 2191 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, these are truly technical corrections. Senator Cullan's staff brought up the fact that there were certain contracts at various stages of negotiation involving old formulas, and in order not to conflict with those the Roads Department brought up the fact that we should make these contracts not apply in LB 42.
