SENATOR KELLY: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Okay, any further questions. Thank you, Speaker Marvel. Well, Senator Wesely we have the job of returning LB 585 which was left hanging here, so the Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 585 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

Mr. Speaker, you want to proceed with the rest of the motions then at this time?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Our agreement was that we would proceed even if the E & R can't get to them. At the moment E & R has called up here and they have processed the...whatever the amendments are on LB 42. That's as far as they have gotten. So whatever your amendments....whatever your motions are, I suggest we proceed with them even if they will not be adopted, because E & R couldn't get them Engrossed.
