LB 329

SENATOR REUTZEL: Question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Reutzel calls for the question. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, debate ceases. Senator Chambers you may close on your motion to return.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I am well aware of all of the things that Senator Labedz has said. But, one mistake she made was when she said a proposal said to elect fourteen members by district and seven at large there has never been anything like that on the ballot in Omaha. As a matter of fact none of the propositions dealt with a seven member council which is the number that I will return this bill to. This is a good faith move on my part. With the adoption of this amendment you will then have the vast majority of the Omaha delegation in support of the bill which will be eight out of twelve. I'm asking that you return the bill, adopt the amendment and then readvance it.

PRESIDENT: Motion before the House is the return of LB 329 for the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays on a motion to return Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, the bill is returned. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendment on LB 329. Any further discussion? If not, all of those in favor of adopting the Chambers amendment on 329 vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays on the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, the amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 329 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 329 to E & R for Engrossment
