The amendment doesn't require an appointment or anything else but it would indicate that a representative of the Governor's office would be free to participate in the discussions if they so chose. I move the adoption of the amendment if that is all right, Senator Kremer.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk will read the amendment to LR 70.

CLERK: Read Warner amendment (See page 2219 of the Legislative Journal).

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? Do you want to move... Senator Warner has moved adoption of his amendment to LR 70. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. We are voting on the Warner amendment to LR 70. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, no nays on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, then the Warner amendment is adopted. We are now ready to adopt the resolution. Senator Kremer, do you have any other comments? Okay, the motion is the adoption of LR 70 as amended. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on LR 70 as amended? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays on the adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The resolution as amended is adopted. Senator Landis, do you want to be recognized now on LR 95?
