CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2251, Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 149 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Chair recognizes Senator Duis on a point of personal privilege.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, a point of personal privilege. Members of the Legislature, I called Senator Hasebroock this morning in the hospital and I reached him directly on the phone. He sounded very chipper and said he was feeling real good. They had had an electrocardiograph this morning and were taking good care of him and that he was feeling okay.

PRESIDENT: That is good news. Thank you, Senator Duis, for that report. We will now proceed then, Mr. Clerk, with the reading of LB 162 on Final Reading.

CLERK: Read LB 162 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 162 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2252, Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 2 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 162 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 172.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 172 on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 172 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 2253, Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 172 passes on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 172A.
