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passage of the Sunshine Act and therefore there is no need for it to be mentioned in the rules. So I would move for the adoption of rule change number one.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? All those in favor of rule change number one as proposed by Senator Fowler vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on rule change number one. Record the vote.

CLERK: 34 ayes, no nays on adoption of the first proposed rule change, Mr. President.

SENATOR FOWLER: I think that we will skip number two for a little bit. We will move to rule change number three. Number three was a rule change introduced by Senator Simon and a number of other senators in response to problems with people addressing the Legislature from the floor who are not senators and having an impact on the flow of legislation. The committee amended it just in terms of altering the language, just to make it clearer. It doesn't change the substance at all. I would move first the committee amendments so that the rule change would read "No individual other than a senator or officer of the Legislature shall be allowed to address the Legislature except from the podium." What that means then is that officers of the Legislature and senators can address the Legislature from the floor, all other guests must address the Legislature from the podium. That is the rule change. It is the concept that Senator Simon had, it is written in one sentence rather than two. I would move for the adoption of that amendment to the Simon rule change and then I don't know if Senator Simon wishes to speak on the rule change or not.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler, are you amending the change, are you presenting the...

SENATOR FOWLER: The committee moved an amendment to rule change number three. I guess I would assume that that amendment has to be adopted as well.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion before the House is the.... we are under item number three of pending rule changes and the motion by Senator Fowler is to adopt the committee amendment to the Simon proposed rule change. All those in favor of that, Senator Koch, excuse me.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I know the reason for this amendment and I think that many of you remember the occasion as well. But it bothers me when we are going to start putting into rules
