be it on the telephone or otherwise, to contact people at home whom we feel have an input to it. I would recommend that this Legislature have the courage to adopt this proposition for at least one year, knowing that at any time during that year if it is unworkable you can alter it by changing the rules. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the rules change number 2. Senator Murphy was closing. All of those in favor of rule change number 2 vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on rule change number 2. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: I would be reluctant to ask for a Call of the House unless I were forced to do so, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are five excused.

SENATOR MURPHY: Then I would ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, it takes 30 votes to change the rule and as I add five and take it away, or subtract five from twelve that leaves me seven and seven and twenty-one make twenty-eight and there just ain't enough unless they change their mind.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Thank you, sir. You ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote? Senator Murphy?

SENATOR MURPHY: Mathematics notwithstanding I'm a gambler, I'd like to see somebody change their mind.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record the vote. The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Maresh, Senator DeCamp, Senator Dworak, Senator Cullan, Senator Haberman, Senator Newell, Senator Chambers, Senator Kelly, Senator Labeledz. Senator Murphy, everybody is here except Senator Chambers. Do you want to go ahead? Call the roll, Mr. Clerk. Senator Murphy said to go ahead.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 27 ayes, 15 nays, 3 excused and not voting 4 present and not voting. Vote appears on pages 2272-2273 of the Legislative Journal.
