PRESIDENT: Yes, thank you. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: And this would only be those that want to leave from Lincoln here. If we put our green light on we are leaving from Lincoln? Otherwise if we are going to go from somewhere else (interruption).

Speaker Marvel, are there any other announcements you want to make before we proceed with Final Reading?

SPEAKER MARVEL: I will make one comment and that is that whatever business is left over after today I assume, in effect, the board will be frozen until we come back in January and thaw it out and then we will start from where we left off.

PRESIDENT: So that means that whatever position the bills are in as we adjourn sine die, that is where they will be when the Legislature comes back next January. So there is no need to make any motion to put anything over. That is where it will be right at that position, so there is no need to bracket is what you are saying, Senator Marvel. All right we are ready then for agenda item #5, Final Reading. Yes, Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. Speaker, then the motions that are now pending on the various bills on the board, do those motions...I apologize for not paying attention earlier. Maybe this was answered earlier but the motions that are now pending on those bills, do they automatically lay over as well or do we start a new come January, 1980?
